A. A way to maintain perspective

- 1. Makes you more gracious to others
- 2. Encourages gratitude to God and those who have helped you along the way

B. A way to maintain foundational values

1. Staying on course requires intentionality (2 Corinthians 13:14 NKJV)

JESUS VERSES RELIGION (John 8:1-12 NKJV)

A. Man-made religion can be harsh

- 1. Proving a point was more important than restoring a person
- 2. The weaker party, the woman, was singled out but where was the man?
- 3. Attempt to back Jesus into a corner to accuse Him

B. The help of the Holy Spirit

- 1. Jesus operated as a man empowered by the Holy Spirit (Isaiah 11:2 NKJV)
- 2. He gave them the one response they could not work around

C. The grace of the Lord

1. Jesus did not condone or condemn her - He was compassionate

D. The love of God
