THINGS THAT DRAIN STRENGTH (Joshua 14:7-9 NKJV)

- The importance of guarding your heart (Proverbs 4:23 NKJV)
 - ◆ Caleb brought back what was in his heart
 - He did not say I brought back the facts
 - What he brought was what God had been saying all along (Numbers 13:1-2 NKJV)
 - ◆ Our words and heart are meant to work together (Matthew 12:35 NKJV)
 - Treasure = deposit
 - · We are the ones who control what is deposited in our hearts
 - ♦ Wrong words can cause heart melt
 - Courage to fail this would be a drain of strength (Psalm 119:28 NKJV)
 - · Right words give strength
 - ♦ Wholly following God was a key to Caleb's strength
 - Involves believing what God has said
 - Holding onto that word in your heart
 - · Lining up words and action
- ❖ The wrong focus (Proverbs 4:20-22 NKJV)
 - ◆ The ten spies brought back a negative report (Numbers 13:31-33 NKJV)
 - · We can not do what God said we could
 - · The people are stronger than we are
 - The land is a devouring land where God called it a land of milk and honey
 - We look like grasshoppers negative self identity
 - ◆ Attention to those words had a negative effect (Numbers 14:1-3 NKJV)
 - Crying, complaining and coming against God and His goodness
 - No battle had been fought
 - ◆ Caleb brought what was in his heart (Numbers 14:7-9 NKJV)
 - · It's a great land a milk and honey land
 - Don't be afraid God will help us
 - With God helping us we can handle these people
 - ◆ Focusing on the negatives and leaving God out causes heart melt
 - Steals our courage and strength (Romans 8:6 NKJV)
