Headlines don't even tell the whole story

- Racial tensions
- Economic tensions a roller coaster ride
- Relational pressures pressures on the home

✤ But we have a promise (John 14:27 NKJV)

- Not begging God for more peace
- ✤ Doing the things that allow His peace more room

A TALE OF TWO LADIES

♦ Martha was stressed (Luke 10:38-42 NASB)

- ✤ Distracted to be drawn in different ways at the same time
- Also stressed due to unmet expectations

✤ A stressed Martha lashes out

- ✦ Accused the Lord of not caring
- ✤ Told the Lord what to do

The Lord's answer was revealing

- Martha, Martha worried and troubled about many things
- ✦ Mary made the right choice
- ✦ Jesus never did make Mary help

CREATING A BETTER ENVIRONMENT FOR PEACE

Align your priorities to line up with God's

- ✤ More peace when it's not all about you
- ✦ Before "seek first" is "don't worry" (Matthew 6:31-33 NKJV)
- Clarify expectations
 - ♦ Between what is expected and what is delivered...
 - ♦ Move out of your comfort zones to clarify (1 Corinthians 14:8 NIV)

✤ Regardless of your circumstances believe that the Lord cares for you

- ♦ When you believe He cares...
 - · Easier to believe you'll come out of a stressful time
 - · You will be less prone to be accusatory or feel the need to beg
- ♦ Believing He cares is foundational to peace (1 Peter 5:6-7 NLT)
 - Opens the door to offloading our cares and creates an environment for His peace to rule
