RESPONSES TO CHRISTMAS CAN VARY

- ❖ A wide range of responses
 - ◆ Excitement of a 5 year old Exhaustion of his mother
 - ♦ Challenging for some
 - ◆ From thrilled to dread

THE FIRST CHRISTMAS CREATED RESPONSES ON MANY DIFFERENT LEVELS (Luke 2:6-20 NKJ)

- ❖ The response of the innkeeper
 - ♦ Completely unaware that God had pierced the darkness through the birth of His Son
 - ♦ He was busy no time and no place
- ❖ King Herod's response
 - ★ Key words here are troubled / threatened
 - ♦ He was well aware of the ancient prophecies of the Jewish Messiah
 - ♦ In Herod's world there was only room for one king
- From one end of the social spectrum a King, to the other the shepherds
 - ♦ These guys were excited
 - ♦ Why these guys? Not near the top of the social order Had to have been a heart thing
 - · A willingness to believe
 - · A lack of fear regarding what others thought may have come off as crazy
 - · The humility to offer God praise
- Joseph and Mary the ones who experienced the birth of Jesus on so many different levels
 - ◆ Their response was deeply personal
 - ♦ The sheer difficulty of processing all that was happening
 - ◆ They took these things to heart and took Jesus home to become a part of their life
 - A place in your heart and a place in your home that's personal

THE DIFFERENT DIMENSIONS OF CHRISTMAS AND THE VARIED RESPONSES CONTINUE TODAY

- The indifference of the innkeeper
 - ♦ Not malicious toward Jesus He just has no place in their lives
 - ♦ Pretty much unaware God is doing amazing things all around them but...
- The troubled anger of King Herod
 - ◆ To some Jesus is troubling a threat
 - ♦ Requires a decision but for many there is only room for one king in their kingdom
- ❖ An inner excitement that exists today and that mirrors the shepherds
 - ◆ An openness to God and a willingness to believe that life is not nearly so random
 - ◆ The hope that God is not only real but He is real good
- ❖ The quiet reflective response of Joseph and Mary
 - ◆ Carried by the belief that not only can God do awesome things He can do them for me personally
 - ♦ God's message to us through the birth of His Son is personal
 - · His salvation is deeply personal
 - ♦ Not totally understanding everything but willing to
 - · Take the step of faith of believing of a simple trust
 - · And making Jesus part of your life, part of your heart part of your home
