THINGS WE UNDERESTIMATE

A. Little things can pack a big punch

- 1. Your toes just break one or get an ingrown toenail
- 2. Small people they will often out work and out perform
- 3. Fire ants in Texas no explanation necessary

B. The Bible highlights another little thing with a big impact (James 3:3-5 NKJ)

- 1. Bits can turn a horse, rudders can turn a ship
- 2. Words (tongue) has a big effect on our lives too often underestimated

A NATION TURNED BY WORDS

A. The negative report (Numbers 13: 27-33 NKJ)

- 1. Started with a visual report of the facts
- 2. Began to add to the report what they feared

B. The positive report from Caleb

- 1. Caleb did not dispute the facts
- 2. His report had one major difference he added what he believed

C. The results of the two reports (Numbers 14:1-4 NKJ)

- 1. The negative report connected with the fear in the people
- 2. The words impacted a nation as if they actually had been defeated in battle
- 3. This was referenced by Caleb over 40 years later (Joshua 14:7-8 NKJ)

Assigning High Value To Your Words

A. Your words have power (Proverbs 18:21 NKJ)

- 1. Use your words to give life positive faith filled words
- 2. Stop speaking the negatives adding fear to the facts

B. Your words can make or break your relationships (Ephesians 4:29 NIV)

- **1.** Unwholesome = rotten
- 2. You can choose words that build up and benefit

C. The highest value words

- 1. Learning to follow God with our words saying what He says
- 2. What He says about who you are
- 3. What He says about His involvement in your life
