### I. CHALLENGES TO DEVELOPING A SEEDS PERSPECTIVE

#### A. We all sow seeds

1. Seeds can be words, actions, material goods, prayers

#### B. Two key areas of resistance (Galatians 6:7 & 9 NKJ)

- 1. Do not believe in the seeds principle
- 2. Tired of sowing good seeds

## II. A WISE WOMAN PLANTS EXCELLENT RELATIONAL SEEDS (1 Sam 25:23-31 NIV)

### A. Abigail went to the one who could resolve the problem

- 1. She did not criticize Nabal for his stupidity
- 2. She went directly to David

#### B. She came bringing gifts

- 1. Food was even more precious in that day than today
- 2. Gifts have a way of calming things

#### C. She believed in David

- 1. Abigal's husband treated David as a runaway slave
- 2. She believed that God had picked David to be the next king

### D. Abigal was concerned about David's interests

- 1. Not just her own safety and that of her household
- 2. She did not want a wrong action to weigh on David's heart

# III. RELATIONSHIP SEEDS ANYONE CAN PLANT

#### A. Go to the one who can fix the problem

- 1. Not complaining to other people
- 2. Many times the "One" to go to is God

#### B. Gifts you give are seeds you sow

- 1. Many ways to give listening, time spent, material gifts, kind acts
- 2. Have to resist the fear of giving (Galatians 6:9-10 NKJV)

#### C. Plant for win/win seeds

1. Not just what works for you, but what works best for them *(1 Corinthians 10:24 NKJV)* 

#### D. Plant seeds of encouragement

- 1. Too much cold cynicism in the world become someone who believes the best
- 2. Look for signs of God working in those around you
