I. BARRIERS TO FINANCIAL SOWING

A. Why the lack of excitement?

- 3. Our money and our heart are closely connected where your treasure is
- 4. Lack of buy-in to sowing and reaping (Luke 6:38 NKJ)

A. Jesus was concerned about hungry people

- 1. He had compassion and taught them
- 2. He did not opt to send them away He fed them

B. What do you have?

- 1. The disciples were thinking what they had in terms of money
- 2. Jesus was talking about a seed
- 3. A boy was willing to sow his lunch put it into Jesus hands

C. Jesus multiplies the seed

- 1. He did not create something out of nothing
- He provided enough for all to be filled
- 3. Twelve baskets taken up

III. SOWING FINANCIAL SEEDS (2 Corinthians 9:6-8 NKJ)

A. How you sow / give

- 1. It's always your call little or much
- 2. Sowing sparingly or bountifully is a function of what you have, a percentage

C. The heart behind your sowing / giving

- 1. With some joy not grudgingly
- 2. Not under pressure compulsion
- 3. Giving with a joyful heart pleases God

C. The results of cheerful sowing / giving

- 1. God can make grace come your way give Him something to work with
- Grace can show up in many different facets jobs, favor, ideas, promotions, deals, money
- 3. An abundance for every good work from His Kingdom to your responsibilities
- 4. He still can multiply your seed (2 Corinthians 9:10 NKJ)
