- 1. Never wasted time has benefits in two realms
- 2. The 3 W's: His Word, His Work, His Worship (2 Chronicles 16:9a NKJ)

CONNECTIONS AND ANSWERS (2 Chronicles 20:14-26 NKJ)

A. Connected to a major problem

- 1. Jehoshaphat faced an army that he was not equipped to handle
- 2. Jehoshaphat had a history of connecting with God in his everyday life

B. An answer comes

1. A priest speaking by inspiration of the Holy Spirit

C. Jehoshaphat and the people make a connection with God

- 1. They praised and worshipped God when they received the promise
- They praised and worshipped God as they were facing the problem
- 3. God showed Himself strong on their behalf took out their enemies

A. Make time for God in your life

- 1. Church will assist you in your connection with God
- 2. Another level exists by devoting personal time (2 Chronicles 19:3 NKJ)

B. Practice worshipping God (John 4:23-24 NKJ)

- 2. As you are facing the problems and challenges
