LOSING AND KEEPING CONFIDENCE

A. Confidence spoilers

- 1. Setbacks
- 2. Broken trust
- 3. Unrealistic expectations

B. Keeping confidence in God (Hebrews 10:35-36 NKJ)

- 1. Our confidence is in the unseen, not the instant
- 2. Our confidence in Him is valuable

WHEN NAAMAN GOT HIS CONFIDENCE BACK (2 Kings 5:1-4; 9-15 NKJ)

A. Confidence sparked

- 1. Naaman heard help was available
- 2. Was willing to make a move toward God

B. Confidence lost

- 1. Naaman was given a promise of healing
- 2. Naaman had a problem with the promise

C. Confidence found

- 1. Naaman had a redeeming quality, humility, a willingness to listen to others
- Made the choice to follow the conditions of the promise
- 3. He made the wise choice to honor God for the results

CONFIDENCE FACTORS

A. Confidence is impacted by what you hear

- 1. Constantly hearing fear filled negative things will take a toll
- 2. Conversely hearing of God's promises and His goodness will have a positive impact (*Romans* 10:17 NKJ)

B. Confidence in God is worth keeping / guarding

- 1. Guard against giving up on His promises
- 2. Confidence protectors

C. Confidence in God is a different and better way to live (2 Corinthians 4:18 NKJ)

- 1. Not limited to what is seen all that we can see is temporary
- Confidence in an unchangeable God and His everlasting Kingdom
