- 2. Text short and sweet and has the option of adding emojis
- Facetime/Skype the ability to see and hear what's being communicated

B. Connecting better with God (James 4:8a NLT)

- 1. The invitation is there the door is open
- 2. Key question is how do we come close?

A. Israel had turned away

- 1. The leaders had turned to Baal
- 2. Difficult days for the nation a drought had impacted them for 3 years

B. A piercing question

- 1. How long will you falter waver; hobbling between two opinions
- 2. The people had no answer they were not settled in their hearts

C. A heart adjustment (1 Kings 18:30, 36-39 NKJ)

- 1. Elijah called the people near and repaired the broken altar of the Lord
- 2. The purpose of the confrontation
- 3. When the fire fell they were singing a different tune
