THE POWER OF PURPOSE

A. Purpose: The reason something is done or created. The reason for which something exists

- 1. A purpose helps move us past obstacles and challenges
- 2. A purpose is the best motivation
- 3. A purpose enhances your life keeps boredom at bay

B. God has designed us to live with purpose (Ephesians 2:10 NKJ)

- 1. You were not a surprise to God
- 2. Purpose built for good works

WHEN UNHAPPY HANNAH ALIGNED WITH GOD

A. Hannah had reasons to be happy

- 1. A husband who loved her despite her inability to have children
- 2. She was well taken care of

B. Hannah brought God into her situation on His terms (1 Samuel 1:10-18 NKJ)

- 1. In her sadness she was able to move beyond her own desires and wants
- 2. She vowed to give away the one thing she wanted most
- 3. She believed God was involved before she ever saw change or progress

C. Hannah got more than she asked for (1 Samuel 2:18-21 NKJ)

- 1. She kept her word and brought her young son Samuel to the temple to live
- 2. God honored her with five more children

ALIGNING WITH GOD

A. Don't wait to be happy

- 1. Always some areas of life that are not perfect
- 2. But we always have something to rejoice about

B. The biggest breakthroughs come when we align with God's purposes for us

- 1. As believers we have a built in purpose (2 Corinthians 5:15 NKJ)
- We can tie into God's Kingdom as opposed to simply protecting our lives (Mark 8:35 NLT)

C. We will never out give God (Matthew 6:33 NKJ)

- 1. Jesus never said seek first the Kingdom and live miserable for the rest of your life
- 2. We align our purposes with God and open the door to His blessings
