THREE KEY THEMES OF THE AVENGERS INFINITY WAR

A. Classic movie themes

- 1. Conflict: The epic battle between good and evil key word is opposition
- 2. Sacrifice: Something surrendered or lost in order to gain an objective
- 3. Resolve: To settle conclusively, decide, firmness of purpose

B. Classic Christian life themes

- 1. Conflict: We face opposition both spiritually and naturally
- 2. Sacrifice: The ultimate sacrifice was made by Jesus
- 3. Resolve: Living for God requires quality decisions and firmness of purpose
- 4. We, as do the Avengers, have an advantage (Philippians 4:11-13 NIV)

BIBLICAL EXAMPLE OF CONFLICT, SACRIFICE AND RESOLVE (1 Samuel 23:1-5 NIV)

A. Conflict

- 1. This fight did not directly involve David
- 2. His concern was for God's people being robbed and frightened

B. Sacrifice

- 1. David and his men had to surrender a place of relative safety to help Keilah
- 2. The natural inclination was to protect and survive David was willing to give that up

C. Resolve

- 1. David was making an "informed" decision praying about his involvement
- 2. Was willing to pray again and with strengthened resolve he engaged in the conflict

CONFLICT, SACRIFICE AND RESOLVE IN OUR LIVES TODAY

A. There is conflict in following God and living a Christian life

- 1. Societal: Pressure/opposition to not stand for Biblical values
- 2. Community: Pressure/opposition from family and friend peers
- 3. Personal: (Ephesians 6:10-13 NIV)

B. Sacrifice is involved in living for God

- 1. Societal: Being identified as a believer ignorant, intolerant a hate monger
- 2. Community: Facing the disapproval of friends and family
- 3. Personal: Saying no to the thoughts and desires of the flesh (Romans 12:1 NIV)

C. Resolve: We have a supernatural source of strength and make informed decisions

- 1. God's word can feed and strengthen our inner man
- 2. God's Holy Spirit lives in us and strengthens us (1 John 4:4 NIV)
