B. Jesus referenced the world we live in (John 16:33 NIV)

- 1. He never indicated we would live trouble free
- 2. He did promise that connected to Him we would have peace
- 3. Our response is to live encouraged; we're on the winning side

NO STORYBOOK LIFE

A. A toxic environment (Genesis 37:2-5 NIV)

- 1. The challenge of 4 wives and 12 sons
- 2. The natural tendency of people to be jealous
- 3. Compounded by the fact that Joseph was obviously favored

B. A dark situation (Genesis 37:24; 26-28 NIV)

- 1. Thrown into a pit with the debate being whether or not to kill him
- 2. Pulled out and sold to slave traders

C. A place with no future (Genesis 39:1-2 NIV)

1. Joseph was not a partner, he was someone's property

D. But there was more to Joseph than what met the eye

- 1. He knew he was loved by his father
- 2. He had dreams from God without a Bible to refer to this was God's promise to him
- 3. The Lord was with Joseph

THE PARALLELS BETWEEN JOSEPH AND US TODAY

A. We can buy into the fact that we are loved

- 1. Love from family and friends is important, but not the last word
- 2. We take God at His word that He really loves us (1 John 3:1a NIV)

B. Connect with God through His word and His promises (2 Peter 1:4 NIV)

1. We have something more sure than a dream

C. Choose to believe that God is with you (Hebrews 13:5-6 NKJV)

1. His presence is not always felt, but His promise to us is more powerful than feelings
