A. When we use the term heart

- 1. To express love for another
- 2. To express courage
- 3. To express an affinity for something

B. Blessings and heart

- 1. Blessings are God's favor, protection, action and involvement in our lives
- 2. Our heart has a part (1 Samuel 16:7 NIV)
- 3. The great news is we can't always change the externals we can change our hearts

A HEART FOR BLESSINGS

A. Solomon had a heart for God (1 Kings 3:3-5 NIV)

- 1. He loved God obeyed God's commandments
- 2. He offered a significant sacrifice to the point that the number was recorded
- 3. He was not perfect didn't worship in the right place

B. Solomon recognized his need for God (1 Kings 3:7-9 NIV)

- 1. He recognized that God was the One who made him king
- 2. He was raised in the palace as an only child and a prince

C. The biggest thing on Solomon's heart was for wisdom to help God's people

- 1. He knew that Israel were God's people
- 2. His heart was to be a blessing

D. Solomon's simple request produced big results (1 Kings 3:10-13 NIV)

- 1. His request pleased God not about him, not about personal gain
- 2. God went way over and above his request

DEVELOPING A HEART FOR BLESSINGS

A. Give God a bigger place

- 1. A love for God will be expressed in words and actions
- 2. Honoring God (Philippians 4:18-19 NIV)

B. Recognize / Acknowledge our need for God

- 1. This is what biblical humility is all about
- 2. We need Him for our salvation and to live for Him (1 Timothy 4:8 NIV)

C. Ask for wisdom to be a blessing to God's people

- 1. Tying our lives to something bigger
- 2. There is a promise associated with a heart for God (Matthew 6:33 NKJV)
