JAMES: AN INTRODUCTION

- He was an important player in the development of the early church
 - ♦ The oldest half brother of Jesus
 - ◆ Saw Jesus after the resurrection and was in the upper room at Pentecost
 - ★ Key leader of believers at Jerusalem some believe the pastor
 - ♦ His letter to the Jews, a practical book, called the Proverbs of the New Testament
 - ◆ James was martyred for his faith in 62AD

STRAIGHT FROM THE START (James 1:1-4 NKJV)

- Count it all joy in the difficulties and tough times
 - ◆ A position we adopt not a feeling we follow
 - Count to regard or consider
- Why do this?
 - ◆ Ultimately it positions us better to win in the end (Nehemiah 8:10 NKJV)
- This is not whistling through the graveyard
 - ◆ Joy because I believe I am coming through this trial
 - ◆ Joy because with God's help I will be standing in the end (2 Timothy 4:14-18 NKJV)
 - ◆ Joy because it's working good things in me

TWO APPROACHES TO TRIALS

- ❖ We're going down (Mark 4:35-40 NKJV)
 - ◆ They were following the Lord's plan to go to the other side
 - ◆ They fall into a bad storm
 - → Jesus' disciples accuse Him of not caring but He was asleep
 - → Jesus rebuked the storm
 - → Jesus challenged the disciples on why so much fear and little faith
- We are praising God
 - ◆ Paul and Silas sent by God into the area (Acts 16:9-10 NKJV)
 - ◆ Persecuted for delivering a demon possessed girl (Acts 16:22-26 NKJV)
 - Prayed and praised God loud enough for others to hear
 - → Had an earthquake that actually was an act of God
