Text: Hebrews 13:8 NKJV

A LADY IN A SEEMINGLY HOPELESS SITUATION (Mark 5:25-29 NKJV)

- She had suffered for a long time
 - ◆ Run out of medical options and run out of money and was not improving
 - ♦ She had not accepted her situation as God's will
- She heard about Jesus
 - → Had to have heard that He was healing people
 - ♦ Most likely heard that people who just touched Him were healed
 - ♦ When she heard faith rose up in her heart (Romans 10:17 NKJV)
- She believed that Jesus' power would heal her
 - ♦ She made no plans to talk to Jesus about her healing
 - ◆ She came from behind so He would not see her
 - ♦ Her only question was would she be able to get to Him to touch His clothes
- Her words and her actions were in agreement
 - ♦ She kept saying
 - ♦ She kept working her way through the crowd
 - ♦ She received healing in her body and she felt it
- The kindness of Jesus (Mark 5:30-34 NKJV)
 - ♦ He knew someone had touched His clothes in a different way
 - ♦ Once again the disciples were baffled
 - ◆ The lady came and told Him the truth
 - → Jesus eliminated the fear that the healing was not for her

REVERSING A LONG TERM SITUATION IN YOUR LIFE

- Not accepting or embracing the situation (Mark 9:23 NKJV)
 - → Jesus said what we believe opens the door to possibilities
 - ♦ With God in our lives we can still keep fighting
- ❖ What we hear is vitally important (Mark 4:24 NIV)
 - ✦ Hearing about all the things that God won't do anymore will limit you
 - ✦ Hearing about a God that has not changed and loves you can alter your perspective
- Believing that God will help you is a major game changer
 - ◆ This is one of the key areas where we need mind renewal
 - ◆ Man plays favorites but not God (Galatians 2:6 NKJV)
 - ◆ The answer is found in our relationship with God through Christ Jesus (Galatians 3:26-28 NKJV)
- Be intentional with your words
 - ◆ Express your faith and trust in God not all your doubts and fears (Hebrews 13:5-6 NKJV)
