STORM SURVIVAL TIPS

MISS ALL YOU CAN (Acts 27:9-13 NKJV)

- Paul's perception might call a gut feeling
 - → The leadership of the Holy Spirit (Romans 8:16 NKJV)
- The opposing arguments
 - ◆ Experience captain Power influence owner
 - ◆ Logic not a good place
 - ◆ Favorable signs a south wind blew softly

DO ALL YOU CAN (Acts 27:14-19 NKJV)

- Use what you have
 - ◆ Experience
 - ♦ Sound sailing principles
 - ◆ They did not give in to "fate"
- ❖ Not either/or (Proverbs 3:5-6 NKJV)
 - ◆ Did not say we abandon our understanding
 - ♦ We can trust God and still utilize natural wisdom

WALK AS CLOSE AS YOU CAN (Acts 27:20-26 NKJV)

- Paul's identity gave him additional confidence
 - ◆ He professed that he belonged to God (1 Corinthians 6:19-20 NKJV)
 - ◆ Peter shared the same concept (1 Peter 1:18-19 NKJV)
- Paul's sense of service gave him confidence
 - ♦ He knew he was serving God, not himself
 - ◆ Serving God is a heart position, not a ministry position (Colossians 3:22-24 NKJV)

DON'T SPEAK UNTIL YOU CAN

- Paul's encouraging words
 - ◆ Take heart seemingly strange words when all hope was gone
 - ◆ Not a hair will fall (Acts 27:34-36 NKJV)
- Paul's timing
 - ◆ Not until he had a message from God do we see him speaking
 - ♦ When we receive God's message i.e. word, promise, impression on our heart ...
