OPENING THE DOOR TO CHANGE

- Open by invitation (John 2:1-11 NKJ)
 - ◆ Jesus was invited to the wedding
 - → Jesus was invited into the problem
 - ♦ Jesus must be invited into our lives
 - Regarding salvation we have to open the door
 - It requires humility on our part to involve Him (James 4:6-8 NKJ)
 - ♦ We also have to invite God into our situations
 - We still have to ask (Matthew 6:7-8 NKJ)
 - Prayer is a major way we involve Him (Philippians 4:6 NKJ)
 - Giving Him our concerns is another way to involve Him (1 Peter 5:6-7 NLT)
 - We can develop a high level of confidence that He can bring change and resolve to our lives
- The value of obeying God's words and ways
 - → Jesus gave some unusual instructions
 - · Fill the water pots made no sense
 - The servants had the opportunity to balk
 - · Instructions were to fill them involved effort
 - ◆ Taking the water to the wedding coordinator was not easy
 - They had to be battling with their senses
 - · Involved a certain level of risk
 - · Without their involvement this miracle does not take place
 - ♦ God's words and ways do not always appeal to the senses
 - Sowing seeds of money and time (Galatians 6:7 NKJ)
 - Words have power (Mark 11:22-24 NKJ)
 - · Believe it before you see it
 - ◆ There is a level of risk in doing things God's way
 - Why we are encouraged to walk by faith (2 Corinthians 5:7 NKJ)
 - · It can rage against our senses called the fight of faith
 - But this is how we please God (Hebrews 11:6 NKJ)
 - He is able to do amazing changes We do our part, He does what we can not do

 - → Jesus provided something different and better
 - ◆ By following God we wind up better
