 - · They had to be battling with their senses
 - Involved a certain level of risk
 - · Without their involvement this miracle does not take place
 - ◆ God's words and ways do not always appeal to the senses
 - Sowing seeds of money and time (Galatians 6:7 NKJV)
 - Words have power (Mark 11:22-24 NKJV)
 - · Believe it before you see it
 - ◆ There is a level of risk in doing things God's way
 - Why we are encouraged to walk by faith (2 Corinthians 5:7 NKJV)
 - · It can rage against our senses called the fight of faith
 - But this is how we please God (Hebrews 11:6 NKJV)
 - He is able to do amazing changes We do our part, He does what we can not do
