- A. How we perceive God's word is important
 - 1. A historical perspective (Luke 8:12 NKJV)
 - 2. As spiritual truth not a regular book of ancient wisdom
 - 3. God's word is alive and powerful (Hebrews 4:12 NKJV)
 - 4. An important key to getting more out of the Bible (Romans 1:16 NKJV)
- B. Connecting with His Kingdom
 - 1. Jesus is king of a different realm (John 18:36-37 NKJV)

LESSONS FROM AN ENCOUNTER (John 4:46-53 NKJV)

- A. A man willing to ask big 17 mile walk to Capernaum
 - 1. He was a royal officer and a desperate father
 - 2. Most likely accustomed to having his way
- B. He was not easily discouraged
 - 1. Jesus' answer did not sound too promising
 - 2. Yet he asked again he could have walked away
- C. An admirable faith
 - 1. Jesus gave him good news and instructions
 - 2. The nobleman believed and acted
- D. Finally saw the answer
 - 1. Some time had passed at least a night and part of a day

 - 1. Continuing to act on God's word without support from senses
